CATCH AN EARLY FLIGHT: PREPARING THE SONS OF GOD TO STAND IN THE GATE

PRAYER FOCUS FOR 50 DAYS

DAY 42

Pray the opening prayer from Day 35.

Today, the Father just wants to enjoy you. Before the foundations of the earth, God purposed you. Your life is not an accident. The original Hebrew actually reads that God variegated or mixed color when He created you. Indeed, you are fearfully and wonderfully made! Let the Father speak to you today about an aspect of your creation and purpose that has been hidden.

Example: By the time I was in 7th grade, because of wounding I could no longer sing. My voice was gone. When I would try to sing - only tears would flow. The Lord began ministering healing and deliverance to me in my early twenties. My voice was restored. Today, I flow in a lot of prophetic song in our ministry. A few years ago, I had an encounter with the Father that brought even more healing to my life. I had a vision of the Father as He was fashioning me in the secret place. He was singing over me. Then, the Word of Lord came. Father God said, "On the day I created you, I sang over you. I put music and song within you. The enemy came to take your voice and your destiny; but I have come to restore you." I am 46 years old. The process of healing goes on...

Read and meditate on the following scriptures.

Today's Scripture Portion:

Psalm 139

Psalm 139:13-14

13 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. 14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

Psalm 139:15-16

15 My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place. When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, 16 your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

Frame OT:6108

otsem (o'-tsem); from OT:6105; power; hence, body:
KJV - might, strong, substance.

Woven/curiously wrought OT:7551

raqam (raw-kam!); a primitive root; to variegate color, i.e. embroider; by implication, to fabricate:

KJV - embroiderer, needlework, curiously work.

to variegate, to mix colors

a) (Qal) variegator (worker in colors) (participle)

b) (Pual) to be skillfully woven

Pray the following:

Father, I love You! There are areas in my life that I don't believe Psalm 139. I don't feel so fearfully and wonderfully made. Holy Spirit, show me what these areas are and why they are there. Jesus, come draw out the pain and heal any wounding. Deliver me of unGodly beliefs about myself and Your purpose for my life. Holy Spirit, heal and fill me now. I take the prophet's word today - that You just want to enjoy me. I draw near to you. Father, reveal to me an aspect of my creation and purpose that has been hidden. Open my eyes, my ears, and my heart to receive. Restore me...Restore the joy of Your Salvation....Let Your pleasure rest upon me.

Sing to the Lord.

**I love you, Lord. And I lift my voice
To worship you, O my soul rejoice
Take joy my King, in what You hear
May it be a sweet, sweet sound in Your ear.**
