CATCH AN EARLY FLIGHT: PREPARING THE SONS OF GOD TO STAND IN THE GATE

PRAYER FOCUS FOR 50 DAYS

DAY 36

Pray the opening prayer from Day 35.

The Father is going to deliver you today from the power of sin and death that has held you in the grave due to your past. Many people are unable to serve God because their conscience condemns them of their past. God has the remedy - His Name is Jesus. It is important for you to know that Jesus Christ has destroyed the **power** of sin, death, disease, sickness, and all the works of the devil. May the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation open your eyes to the power of the Blood of Jesus. God is the God of redemption. He has purchased us from the slave market of sin and death through His shed blood and the completed work of the cross. He has a magnificent plan for your life. When you accepted Jesus Christ, an exchange was made in the spirit. His perfect life for your imperfect; your sins/Him sinless; your sickness and disease/His health; your death/His life; your weakness/His power; your defeat/His victory; your poverty/His wealth. The Father wants you to know that He has a redemptive plan in your DNA. You have a "hope and a future" planned before the foundations of the earth. God is no longer counting our sins against us. In fact, when the Father looks at you, He sees the blood. Your sins and lawless acts, He remembers no more. That's what the Word of God says. To continually agonize over your past is really prideful because, in essence, you are saying and believing that the blood of Jesus is not enough. **Remember**, He is calling you out of the grave and the grave clothes. Change your garments!

Read and meditate on the following scriptures.

Today's Scripture Portion:
Hebrews 9:11-Hebrews 10

John 11:43-44

43 When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" 44 The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Jesus said to them, "Take off the grave clothes and let him go." (NIV)

Hebrews 9:14-15

14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! 15 For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance—now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant. (NIV)

Hebrews 10:15-18

15 The Holy Spirit also testifies to us about this. First he says: 16 "This is the covenant I will make with them after that time, says the Lord. I will put my laws in their hearts, and I will write them on their minds." 17 Then he adds: "Their sins and lawless acts, I will remember no more." 18 And where these have been forgiven, there is no longer any sacrifice for sin.

Romans 8:1-2

1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

2 Corinthians 5:21

God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. (NIV)

Pray the following:

Father, I receive Your Word. Come, Holy Spirit. Open my understanding to the power of the blood of Jesus. Reveal the places in my heart and mind that are held captive by sin and death because of my past. I confess the sin of pride for any place that I have been holding on to sin and death and not receiving the full benefits of the blood covenant. Father, forgive me and cleanse me of all unrighteousness. Jesus, come and wash the windows of my conscience, my heart, and soul with Your blood and the water of Your Word. Take the memory track and the walls that have held these things in place. I choose life and the destiny that You have for me. I choose to serve You, Lord. Come, Holy Spirit. Heal and fill these areas. I receive the inheritance that is mine in Christ. I agree with the Word of God. Holy Spirit, restore my walk and the labor of my hands. Father, reveal a plan that You have for me. In the Name of Jesus, I pray.

Note: I encourage you to begin and end each session with praise/worship as your time permits. It does not have to be long. It can simply be vocal praise and adoration.

Example: *I worship You, Father. I praise Your Holy Name, Jesus. You are my Abba and I worship You. You are Lord, Jesus, and I worship You... Come, Holy Spirit of Worship. Come in the Name of Jesus. Come and fill this place...*
