CATCH AN EARLY FLIGHT: PREPARING THE SONS OF GOD TO STAND IN THE GATE

PRAYER FOCUS FOR 50 DAYS

DAY 38

Pray the opening prayer from Day 35.

The Lord is going to remove any remaining residue and effects of the grave from us today. We are going to literally call upon the Name of the Lord and be saved out of the grave of sin, regret, grief, sorrow and death that has held us captive. This is a final search for the Holy Spirit so that your walk and the labor of your hands can be fully restored. The favor of the Lord is extended to you today! Today is the day of Salvation.

Read and meditate on the following scriptures.

Today's Scripture Portion:

John 11:43-44

43 When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" 44 The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Jesus said to them, "Take off the grave clothes and let him go." (NIV)

Isaiah 49:8-9

8 This is what the LORD says: "In the time of my favor I will answer you, and in the day of salvation I will help you; I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people, to restore the land and to reassign its desolate inheritances, 9 to say to the captives, 'Come out,' and to those in darkness, 'Be free!' NIV

Isaiah 61:1-3

The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, 2 to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, 3 and provide for those who grieve in Zion--to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. NIV

2 Corinthians 6:2

For he says, "In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you." I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation. NIV

Psalms 142:5-7

5 I cry to you, O LORD; I say, "You are my refuge, my portion in the land of the living." 6 Listen to my cry, for I am in desperate need; rescue me from those who pursue me, for they are too strong for me. 7 Set me free from my prison, that I may praise your name. NIV

Pray the following:

Father, this is it. I receive Your favor, the salvation ministry of Jesus, the good news of the gospel, healing for the brokenhearted places in me, freedom from blindness (no vision), freedom from prison. Come now, Holy Spirit, and remove any remaining residue and effects of sin, death, regret, grief, and sorrow from my heart and life. I cry out to You, Lord. Jesus, release Your anointing within me to destroy every yoke of the enemy. I receive Your comfort into my life instead of mourning. Jesus, You have carried all grief and sorrow. I lay down these burdens. I am ready to exchange the grave clothes for the crown of beauty instead of ashes. All feeling and beliefs of worthlessness and hopelessness goes from my life now - in the Name of Jesus. I exchange mourning for Your oil of gladness, and the despair for the garment of praise. I receive Your abundant life, Jesus. In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Amen!
