CATCH AN EARLY FLIGHT: PREPARING THE SONS OF GOD TO STAND IN THE GATE

PRAYER FOCUS FOR 50 DAYS

DAY 37

Pray the opening prayer from Day 35.

Today, we are specifically going to deal with anything that has obscured or taken your vision. The Father wants to restore your sight and remove the "grave cloth" that has covered your face. This is going to affect your spiritual senses - eyes, ears, nose, mouth, mind, heart... Where there is no vision, there is death. Look at the definitions for vision and perish. Where there is no revelation from God, these are things that people do with the plan and destiny that God has for them: they hold back, dismiss it, let go of it, let loose of it, avoid it, neglect it, cast off restraint, go back, refuse it, and perish. **That is death! We will never be truly satisfied until we are fulfilling God's purposes for our lives.**

Vision: chazown (khaw-zone') a sight (mentally), i.e. a dream, revelation, or oracle:
vision

- a) *a vision (while in an ecstatic state)*

Perish: para` (paw-rah'); a primitive root; to loosen; by implication, to expose, dismiss; figuratively, absolve, begin: KJV - avenge, avoid, bare, go back, let (make) naked, set at naught, perish, refuse, uncover

- 2) *to let go, to let loose, to ignore, to let alone*

Read and meditate on the following scriptures.

Today's Scripture Portion:

John 11:43-44

43 When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" 44 The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Jesus said to them, "Take off the grave clothes and let him go." (NIV)

Proverbs 29:18

Where there is no vision, the people perish... (KJV)

Proverbs 29:18

Where there is no vision [no redemptive revelation of God], the people perish; (AMP)

Hosea 4:6

my people are destroyed from lack of knowledge. (NIV)

Note: This Scripture is listed in inverted form: verses 14 to 11. We are praying it this way.

Jeremiah 29:14-11

14 I will be found by you," declares the LORD, "and will bring you back from captivity.

13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

12 Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you.

11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. (NIV)

Pray the following:

Father, I choose life. I choose to come out of captivity in the Name of Jesus. I seek You with all of my heart. I call upon Your Name, Jesus. Come, Lord Jesus. Come, Holy Spirit, and remove the grave cloth from my face. Reveal to me anything that has obscured my vision and Your vision for my life. Reveal to me any unGodly beliefs about my destiny and future. Jesus, draw them out of me and deliver me. I turn my spirit toward You, Father of my spirit. Speak to me. Renew the vision and reveal to me the plans and purposes that You have for me. Renew my mind. May the eyes of my heart be enlightened to know the glorious inheritance and riches that You have stored in me. Unpack me, Holy Spirit. Spirit of Resurrection, Life and Power, restore my dreams and vision. Jesus, You have been to the end of my destiny and have come back. I ask You to walk with me by Your Spirit each day. Let me hear Your voice. Be my guide. I fix my eyes and thoughts on You, Jesus. I set my heart on things above. In Jesus' Name!
