CATCH AN EARLY FLIGHT: PREPARING THE SONS OF GOD TO STAND IN THE GATE

PRAYER FOCUS FOR 50 DAYS

DAY 12

Pray the opening prayer from Day 9. Review the scriptures from Day 9. Remember: Take your time as you pray the prayer. Let the words and what you are asking saturate your being. See it being done as you pray.

Pray the following:

Father, reveal to me any areas in my life where there is fear that You want to deal with today. Reveal to me any areas where fear came in as a result of being abandoned or by feelings of abandonment. Show me any places that I don't trust You and why. Show me any places that I felt abandoned by others and why. Show me what to do with this. Draw out the pain and fear. Holy Spirit, come heal, fill and give life to those areas with the love of God, Your Presence, and the promises of Your Word. I receive healing and wholeness in these/this area of my life. *(If this is a childhood incident or womb incident, see Jesus and the Father there with you.)*

Decree and declare these scriptures aloud:

1 John 4:16-18

16 God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him. 17 In this way, love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment, because in this world we are like Him. 18 There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.

Hebrews 13:5-6

God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?" (NIV)

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. (NIV)

Deuteronomy 31:8

The LORD Himself goes before you and will be with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. (NIV)

Pray the following:

Father, let Your perfect love drive this fear out of every chamber of my heart. Fill me with Your love and acceptance.

Ephesians 1:3-7

*3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, 4 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which **He has made us accepted in the Beloved.** (NKJV)*
