PRAYER FOCUS FOR 50 DAYS

DAY 40

Pray the opening prayer from Day 35.

Lazarus came out of the tomb with his hands and his feet bound and his face covered. He needed his vision, walk, and labor of his hands restored. Today, Father God is going to restore the labor of your hands and your productivity. We are going to present our hands to God for washing!

Read and meditate on the following scriptures.

Today's Scripture Portion:

John 11:43-44

43 When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" 44 The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Jesus said to them, "Take off the grave clothes and let him go." (NIV)

1 Corinthians 12:21

The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!" (NIV)

Psalms 24:3-4

3 Who may ascend the hill of the LORD? Who may stand in his holy place? 4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to an idol or swear by what is false

James 4:8

Come near to God and He will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. (NIV)

Psalms 119:48

I lift up my hands to your commands, (NIV)

Psalms 26:6

I wash my hands in innocence, and go about your altar, O LORD, (NIV)

Psalm 18:34

He trains my hands for battle; (NIV)

Psalm 90:17

May the favor of the Lord our God rest upon us; establish the work of our hands for us-- yes, establish the work of our hands. (NIV)

Pray the following:

Father, I receive Your Word and agree with the Words of Jesus. "Take off the grave clothes and let him go!" I desire freedom in my vision, walk, and the labor of my hands.
